

SCENARIO PACK 1: A WORLD AT WAR

ERRATA

Hazmo2 (“Crown of Thorns”)

Under the German OB, the “PzKpfw 38(t)” should read “PzKpfw 38(t)A.”

Hazmo3 (“Seaside Retreat”)

Delete sentence “A” in SP 2 (i.e. FFI Reinforcement hex is chosen after Rubble placement but prior to all setup).

Hazmo4 (“Kids These Days”)

The first printing (only) of this scenario contained a typo. Under “Parity,” the British section should read: “Replace one PzKpfw VIE(L) with a PzKpfw VIE.”

Hazmo9 (“Cloak and Dagger”)

Delete “[EXC: Fortified Building Location]” in SP1.

Q & A

Hazmo2 (“Crown of Thorns”)

Do the Armored Cupolas have a ROF of 2 and B11?

Yes.

Hazmo3 (“Seaside Retreat”)

Do the Free French use the Free French counters with squads with a smoke exponent of 2 or 1/0? I think the former, but just checking.

That is correct. The FF counters with the exponent of 2 are used.

Hazmo9 (“Cloak and Dagger”)

Can the French enter different groups on the same area? Or do they all have to be different?

Yes, they can enter different groups in the same area. However, they are not allowed to enter a single group in two or more different areas.

Are the Free French Vehicle Crews French (with 8 morale) or American (with 7 morale)?

The Free French Vehicle Crews are French, not American.

SCENARIO PACK 2: THE UN-CIVIL WARS, 1936-1949

ERRATA

Hazmo13 (“Tin Men in Tianmen”)

In SP1, add the following sentence: “Place Ford counters in M8 and S2.”

The Japanese 8-0 Leader is not Wounded. Ignore the “3MF” on the counter.

Hazmo18 (“Sophoclean Tragedy”)

In British OB (“Trapped Paras”), replace “Set up second in Building hexes M8, M9, O9 and P8” with “Set up second in Buildings M8, M9, O9 and P8”

SP4 states that only a Republican Unit that “has not yet fired” is eligible to make a Dynamite/Rock dr. Is a MMC that has fired a SW but not its Inherent FP eligible to make a Dynamite/Rock dr?

SCENARIO PACK 3: CITY OF STEEL

ERRATA

CToS Multi-Applicable Scenario Parameters

CToS9: Delete “2-3-7.”

CToS12 *and* 13: CG5 (GUN/AFV), CG8 (SNIPERS) and CG17 (SELF-RALLY) are also NA.

Hazmo28 (“Righteous Red Scythe”)

Delete the second sentence of SP9.

Under “Board Orientation,” replace overlay **X17** with **X7** (as per SP2).

Hazmo29 (“The Heights of Hubris”)

Add a “2” under the image of the T-70 (i.e. the Russians receive two T-70s, not just one).

Q&A

Hazmo28 (“Righteous Red Scythe”)

Is the Dry Stream treated as a Gully (as per 20.41) or a Stream (as per B33.11)?

The Dry Stream is treated as a Gully. Hence, the portion of the Dry Stream that contains Woods is treated as a Gully-Woods hex (see B19.4).
